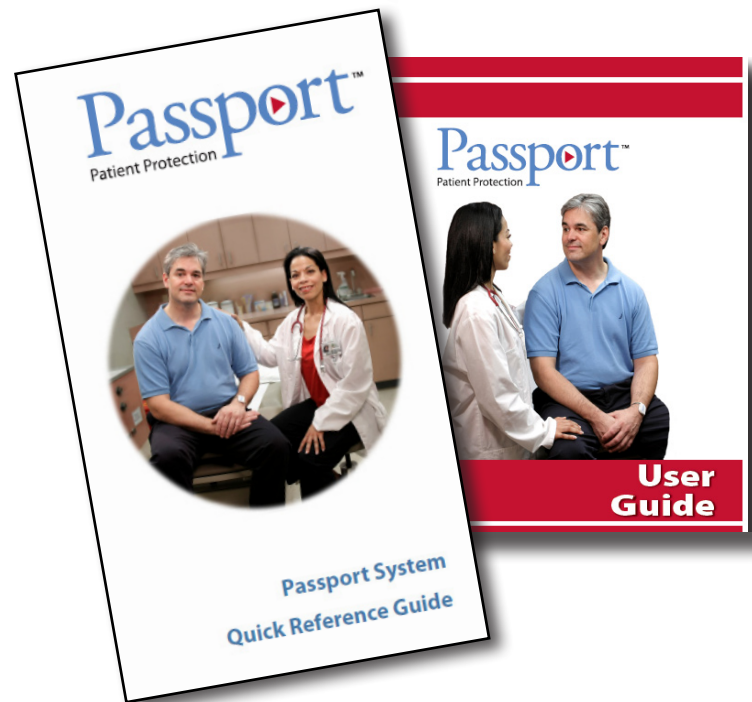

What's in your Kit

Here's what you'll find inside:

- ✓ **Sizing Guides (box of 200):** The disposable paper guides are used to measure the patient's wrist or ankle before cutting the banding material to size.
- ✓ **Bands (Pkg of 50):** Individually sealed and ready to be cut-to-size for each patient.
- ✓ **Removal Keys (20):** A plastic device used to quickly and easily release the band from the tag housing. May be attached to a lanyard if desired.
- ✓ **Band Clippers (2):** These special clippers are designed to cut through the tough banding material to obtain a custom-fitted band for each patient.
- ✓ **Passport Quick Reference Guide (3):** This reference guide covers all the essential functions of the Passport software, including alarms and applying the tag.
- ✓ **Passport User Guide:** A complete guide to using the Passport software.
- ✓ **Test items:** The MyCall tag and Exciter Tester are for testing your Passport system, with the assistance of your dealer.

Clinical Services

Go Live Support Package

Three days on site by the clinical educator, usually broken down into two days of training, and one day of support on your first day of using the system. The first half of the first day is a special four-hour management level training session to finalize optional configurations, user account set up and nursing policy and procedure. The bundle is adequate for a facility with up to 100 staff members requiring training. Extra days (one day for every 60 staff members) may be added for an additional charge.

Clinical Education Package

Similar to Go Live Support, this package offers the same two days of training, but does not include support on your first day of using the system. The bundle is adequate for a facility with up to 100 staff members requiring training. Extra days (one day for every 60 staff members) may be added for an additional charge.

Refresher Training Package

This package is designed for customers who are already using the system. This one-day session provides refresher training for up to 60 staff members. Extra days (one day for every 60 staff members) may be added for an additional charge.

Clinical Site Consultation

This customizable service is designed to help optimize use of your system. A clinical consultant will be on site for one day to help identify strategies to reduce end-user issues through software configuration changes and clinical practice recommendations.

On-Site System Administrator Training

A two-day course for facility staff responsible for administering the system. The material of this course is covered in the Patient Security User Conference (see below).

Patient Security User Conference

The Patient Security User Conference covers a range of topics on patient security, including best practises for using the system. It is offered at various times in different locations around the country, and two spots are included in the purchase price for the system.
